Month to 31 January 2022

PIP announced an unaudited net asset value ("NAV") per share as at 31 January 2022 of 412.3p, a decrease of 3.0p (-0.7%) from the NAV per share as at 31 December 2021.

In the month to 31 January 2022, valuation losses* were -4.5p (-1.1%), investment income* added +0.1p (+0.0%), foreign exchange movements* were +2.4p (+0.6%) and expenses and taxes**** were -1.0p (-0.2%).

PIP's valuation policy for private equity funds is based on the latest valuations reported by the managers of the funds in which PIP has holdings. In the case of PIP's valuation as at 31 January 2022, 12% of reported valuations are dated 31 December 2021 or later, 86% are dated 30 September 2021 and 2% are dated 30 June 2021.

At 31 January 2022, PIP's private equity assets stood at £2,059m, whilst net available cash balances^ were £219m. The Asset Linked Note^^ ("ALN") outstanding as at 31 January 2022 amounted to £52m. Undrawn commitments to investments stood at £645m as at 31 January, calculated using exchange rates at that date. PIP's multi-

currency revolving credit facilities comprise a US\$269.8m facility and a €101.6m facility, which remained undrawn as at the month end.

PIP made £32.7m of new commitments during the month to two primaries (£27.2m), one secondary (£2.8m), and one co-investment (£2.7m). These included:

- A £15.7m primary commitment to a North American venture fund.
- An £11.5m primary commitment to LYFE Capital Fund IV, an Asian growth equity fund.
- A £2.7m co-investment alongside Altamont Capital Partners in Accelerant, a tech-enabled specialty insurance risk exchange platform based in the USA.
